

REQUIREMENTS FOR NATIONAL JUNIOR HONOR SOCIETY

1. Students who have maintained a 3.8 academic average through six quarters at Woodbury (all of grade 6 and the first two quarters of grade seven) are invited to fill out the application form in the spring of seventh grade.
2. Students are asked to list their membership in both school and community activities, including sports, music, etc.
3. Students are asked to list leadership positions in both school and the community.
4. Students are asked to list service to both the school and community.
5. Finally, students are asked to explain in writing why they should be members of the National Junior Honor Society.

Please note: These requirements are from the local and national chapter regulations. Also, membership at the Woodbury does not mean automatic membership in high school nor does exclusion at Woodbury mean a student will not be invited/accepted at Salem High.

Any student who has been suspended is ineligible.
